



Promoting Strong Parishes

The parishes of the Diocese of Worcester are active and vital parts of the Catholic Church's ministry and are a great gift of God to help us share our faith.

As a center of our Christian life, our parish is the place where we worship, where we hear God's Word, where we experience God's love, where we are nourished to live our mission in the world, where we find fellowship with our brothers and sisters in Christ, where we baptize and educate our children, where we see them grow closer to God through Eucharist, Penance, Confirmation and Matrimony, and where we seek consolation as we bury our beloved dead.

In spite of difficult times, those who preceded us sacrificed to build the parishes we enjoy. Now it is our time to step forward to keep our parishes strong.



What Constitutes a Strong Parish?

- The people in leadership have a shared sense of mission
- Its people are actively involved and committed to the work of God
- There is a vibrant worshipping community with full and active participation
- There is sufficient financial support to provide for our maintenance and growth

How is the Offertory Used?

For years, parishes have relied on the generosity of their parishioners to fund:

- Liturgies & Ministries
- Staff Salaries & Benefits
- Utilities, Upkeep & Maintenance
- Insurance & Diocesan Obligations

Parishes also sponsor youth sports teams, provide for those in need, promote social justice programs, and do countless other projects in their communities.

How Will This Effort Help?

Through *Sharing Our Blessings*, we aim to invite parishioners to consider how the parish accomplishes all it does with limited resources and to imagine the potential that exists if every parishioner could make a faith commitment to increase and sustain his or her financial support.

What is Being Asked of us?

During this increased offertory initiative, we should all examine how truly fortunate we are as members of God's family. In response and in gratitude we are asked to make financial commitments representing our 'return' to God.

For too long, pastors and parishioners have avoided the conversation about the true costs of running a parish.

Part of the reason we have avoided the conversation is that for generations, parishes have benefited from an abundance of priests and religious vocations. Parishes today must strive to hire professional staff and offer fair compensation. It simply costs much more money now to maintain a strong and vibrant parish.

In 2010, every parish in the Diocese of Worcester will join in a common purpose: to change the way we think about our donations and to plan for a brighter future in each of our faith communities by gradually increasing and sustaining our levels of support.

By conducting *Sharing Our Blessings*, parishes will realize immediate increases in their offertory income and will be able to plan accordingly.

Christ's Teachings on Giving

Almost half of the parables of Jesus include references to stewardship and money. Jesus preached being a good steward and the Bible interprets this as giving back to God the first fruits of our labors.

How Christians have chosen to apply 'first fruits' over the years is, of course, very different. The message is clear, however: **Everything we have is a gift from God and we are asked to return a portion of those gifts in gratitude for all we have.**

Today, let us begin an examination of our personal blessings.

Stewardship giving is a conscious way of supporting the weekly collection through annual planning. It means that we take some time every year to consider seriously our donations in support of our parish's annual budget and make a sustainable commitment.
