Most Rev. Robert J. McManus, D.D., S.T.D. Bishop of Worcester

Having been ordained a priest May 27, 1978, Bishop McManus was ordained a Bishop on February 22, 1999, and was Auxiliary Bishop of Providence. He was installed as the Fifth Bishop of Worcester on May 14, 2004. He graduated from Catholic University of America, 1973, with a B.A. in Philosophy, *Summa Cum Laude* and with an M.A. from Catholic University of America, 1974, *Summa Cum Laude*. He holds an M.Div. from Toronto School of Theology, 1977, an S.T.L. from the Pontifical Gregorian University, *Magna Cum Laude*, 1986 and an S.T.D (Moral Theology) from the Pontifical Gregorian University *Magna Cum Laude* in 1987. He has served as a Parochial Vicar, a Catholic Chaplain for the Community College of R.I., an Instructor in Philosophy, Providence College, Director, Office of Ministerial Formation, Diocese of Providence: June 1986 – June 1999, Vicar for Education, Diocese of Providence, November 1987 – July 2002 and Theological Consultant /Editorial Writer, *The Providence Visitor*, October 1990 – July 2002.

Rev. Tadeusz Pacholczyk, (Fr. Tad) Ph.D

After earning a Ph.D in Neuroscience from Yale University, Fr. Tad did post-doctoral research at Massachusetts General Hospital/Harvard Medical School. He subsequently studied in Rome where he did advanced studies in theology and in bioethics. He is Director of Education for the National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia and directs the Center's National Catholic Certification Program in Health Care Ethics.

Dr. Roland Millare, S.T.D.

A native of Houston, Texas, Dr. Roland Millare serves as the Director of Shepherd's Heart for the St. John Paul II Foundation (Houston, TX). He also serves as the Theology Department Chairperson at St. John XXIII College Preparatory (Katy, TX). He has an M.A. in Theological Studies (with a concentration in Moral Theology) from Notre Dame Graduate School of Christendom College in Alexandria, Virginia, a Licentiate and a Doctorate in Sacred Theology in Dogmatic Theology (with a concentration in Sacramental Theology) from the Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake (Mundelein, IL). He is an adjunct professor of theology for permanent deacon candidates at St. Mary's Seminary. Dr. Millare lives with his wife Veronica and two daughters, Gabriella and Karolina.
